GENERAL INFORMATION

SELECTION OF AWARD FINALISTS

- A Selection Panel (appointed by Noosa Regional Gallery) will review all applications to recommend a shortlist of finalists for exhibition. Please refer to the Conditions of Entry for more information.
- Selection/Exhibition of artwork shall be at the absolute discretion of Noosa Regional Gallery. No reason will be given, or communication entered into by the Gallery, its staff or its agents with regard to the selection of the shortlist of finalists for exhibition.
- Entry in the Award is through pre-selection from digital image/s only of work submitted for entry.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

ELIGIBILITY

- Only students currently in year 9, 10, 11 and 12 are eligible to enter.
- Entries must be the original, unaided work of the entrant.
- No work submitted shall have been entered into Draw from previous years.
- Only work that has been completed in the twelve month previous to the closing date will be considered.
- **DRAW 2019** is open to Australian students living on the Sunshine Coast or Gympie Region.
- No third party or commercial gallery may enter works on behalf of a student.
- Entries representing partnerships between individuals will be accepted as one entry and on the understanding that each partner's contribution is deemed equal.
- Entries must follow the overall size limits. Work must not be bigger than two (2) metres in any dimension.
- Hanging of student works. **Work may be submitted framed or unframed.**
Framing requirements: D-rings, suitable to support the weight of the work/frame, must be screwed to the back of the frame at each side 100mm from top of work. If not present, D-rings will be fitted by the Gallery.
Unframed works on paper will be installed with magnets unless otherwise instructed by the student. **Please contact the Gallery for assistance if required.**
- All drawings will be considered including those on paper, canvas, Perspex, board, fabric or other alternative and inventive materials. Submissions may be an innovative or more traditional style drawing in ink, charcoal, markers, pencil, pastel or other favoured medium. Animations are accepted.
- Selected works will be displayed in the gallery alongside practicing artists.
- Digitally created or edited works including works created with digital pen on a graphics tablet are not eligible to enter.
- All works entered into the award must be available for display for the entire duration of the exhibition. **Artworks can be for sale.**
- Judges of DRAW and Noosa Council employees are not eligible to enter.

APPLICATION

- A complete online application means the upload of the following:
- Name of student
Address of student
School student is attending (proof required if shortlisted)
Parents' consent (parents will need to give written consent for students shortlisted for the award)
- Works chosen for the exhibition will be pre-selected from digital images
- Digital image(s), please send images in the following formats:
Up to 2 digital images per work (ie: a detail and work in its entirety) in JPEG format, of no less than 300DPI with file size of no less than 1.5MB and no larger than 2MB in size. Files should be clearly named with artist's surname and first initial followed by title, medium and dimensions (h x w) of the work as follows:

PRE-SELECTION / JUDGING

- All entries submitted will be presented for review to a pre-selection panel, from which a limited number works will be selected to exhibit in **Draw 2019**.
- Artworks will be shortlisted by a professional panel based on a set of curatorial rationale including concept, workmanship and originality.
- Once the pre-selection process has been completed, all entrants will be advised of the outcome.
- The judge, at their discretion, may award multiple non-monetary commendations to entries they deem worthy.
- Pre-selection panel and Judge's decision/s for the **Draw 2019** is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

DELIVERY AND TRANSPORT OF SELECTED ARTWORK

- Transit insurance is the responsibility of the student.
- The Gallery accepts no responsibility for the storage of uncollected work beyond 14 days after the exhibition closing date.
- The Gallery will not meet any expenses associated with return/collection of work.
- Selected works must be delivered with the name of the student, return address, contact information, title, date and medium attached to the work, and securely packaged to ensure safe transportation to and from the Gallery. The packaging must be suitable for the Gallery to re-use for the return of the selected artwork.

COPYRIGHT

- Entrants warrant that they are the copyright owner of the artwork submitted with this entry form and agree to indemnify Noosa Regional Gallery and its staff for any breach or infringement of copyright.
- The Gallery reserves the right to reproduce and/or edit any digital images submitted with the entry form, for archival, catalogue or promotional purposes including electronic and digital promotional activities. All reasonable care will be taken to maintain the artistic integrity of any edited images.
- The Gallery will allow the taking of photographs via mobile devices such as Smart Phones and iPads for personal use by members of the public during the exhibition. Members of the public are responsible for the copyright of the images they take.
- The winners will grant Noosa Regional Gallery/Noosa Council a non-exclusive, perpetual copyright licence to reproduce the work for non-commercial purposes.
- Attribution of the artist as the author of the work by Noosa Regional Gallery/Draw 2019 will be made wherever the work is reproduced unless it is reasonable in the circumstances not to do so.

WORKS FOR FINAL EXHIBITION

- The Noosa Regional Gallery reserves the right to determine the most appropriate method for displaying works to ensure public safety and to refuse to display any works deemed inappropriate or unsafe.
- Substitutes for a selected work will not be accepted.
- Shortlisted work is to be delivered to the Noosa Regional Gallery between the hours of **10am and 3pm from Tuesday 22 to Sunday 27 October 2019**, unless otherwise agreed.
- The finalists selected for **Draw 2019** will receive further details on participation in the Award.
- **Works may be offered for sale** throughout the duration of the exhibition the Gallery will add 30% as commission on the sale price.
- **Collection** of all unsold work is the responsibility of the artist. Works must be collected from the Noosa Regional Gallery between the hours of 10am - 4pm from Monday 2 to Tuesday 3 December, 2019, unless otherwise arranged.
- **Collection** of sold work is the responsibility of the purchaser and must be collected from the Noosa Regional Gallery between the hours of 10am - 4pm from Monday 2 to Tuesday 4 December, 2019.

INTERPRETATION OF THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

In the event of a dispute regarding the interpretation of the **DRAW 2019** terms and conditions, the decision of Noosa Regional Gallery shall be binding on all parties. Please Note: Unless the contrary intention appears in the wording of this form, words in the singular number include the plural and words in the plural number include the singular. The terms "Gallery" refer to "Noosa Regional Gallery" and the term "work" in the context of this entry form refers to an Artwork. Noosa Regional Gallery reserves the right to cancel or postpone the **DRAW 2019** and exhibition.
