GENERAL INFORMATION

SELECTION OF AWARD FINALISTS

- A Selection Panel (appointed by Noosa Regional Gallery) will review all applications to recommend a shortlist of finalists for exhibition. Please refer to the Conditions of Entry for more information.
- Selection/Exhibition of artwork shall be at the absolute discretion of Noosa Regional Gallery. No reason will be given, or communication entered into by the Gallery, its staff or its agents with regard to the selection of the shortlist of finalists for exhibition.
- Entry in the Award is through pre-selection from digital image/s only of work submitted for entry.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

ELIGIBILITY

- Only students currently in year 9, 10, 11 and 12 are eligible to enter.
- Entries must be the original, unaided work of the entrant.
- No work submitted shall have been entered into Draw from previous years.
- Only work that has been completed in the twelve month previous to the closing date will be considered.
- **DRAW 2020** is open to Australian students living on the Sunshine Coast or Gympie Region.
- No third party or commercial gallery may enter works on behalf of a student.
- Entries representing partnerships between individuals will be accepted as one entry and on the understanding that each partner's contribution is deemed equal.
- All drawings will be considered including those on paper, canvas, perspex, board, fabric or other alternative and inventive materials including drawn animations and works created with digital pen on a graphics tablet are eligible to enter. (Please note, as these will only be displayed online, it is important that you choose a medium that translates well in this context)



- Submissions may be an innovative or more traditional style drawing in ink, charcoal, markers, pencil, pastel or other favoured medium. (Please note, as these will only be displayed online, it is important that you choose a medium that translates well in this context)
- Selected works will be displayed on a website nominated by and associated with Noosa Regional Gallery.
- Judges of DRAW and Noosa Council employees are not eligible to enter.

APPLICATION

- All applications to **DRAW 2020** must be submitted online through Noosa Council's Smarty Grants website. <https://noosa.smartygrants.com.au/>

- A complete online application means the upload of the following:
 - Name of student
 - Address of student
 - Name of the School the student is attending
 - Copy of the Student ID a photograph of the student ID is acceptable
 - Parents' consent
- Works chosen for the exhibition will be pre-selected from digital images
The digital images will be used for the online exhibition therefore please send images in the following formats:
- A complete online application means the upload of the following:
 - Digital image(s), please send images in the following formats:
 - Up to 3 digital images per work as follows:
 - 2 detailed images of the work.
 - 1 Image in its entirety (the whole image). Where possible, please provide this image cropped so that no background is visible. Where images with visible backgrounds are supplied, the gallery will crop these so that only the artwork is visible. To aid this, please take the photo in front of a solid coloured background (preferably white), hanging on a wall and front on (parallel with your lens). If you take a photo with your artwork laying down ensure your lens is parallel with your artwork.
 - In JPEG format. Images should be no less than 300dpi with a file size of no less than 2 MB and not larger than 5MB.
 - Files must be clearly named with artist's surname and first initial followed by title, medium and dimensions (h x w) of the work as follows:
SurnameF_Titleofwork_charcoal on paper_140x160cm.
 - Images supplied must be of professional quality for reproduction and include photographer's name. **As this prize will be solely viewed, shortlisted and judged from the images supplied by artists, the quality of these will be a consideration in the selection process.**



PRE-SELECTION / JUDGING

- All entries submitted will be presented for review to a pre-selection panel, from which a limited number of works will be selected to exhibit in **Draw 2020**
- Artworks will be shortlisted by a professional panel based on a set of curatorial rationale including concept, workmanship and originality.
- Once the pre-selection process has been completed, all entrants will be advised of the outcome.
- The judge, at their discretion, may award multiple non-monetary commendations to entries they deem worthy.
- Pre-selection panel and Judge's decision/s for the **Draw 2020** is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

COPYRIGHT
