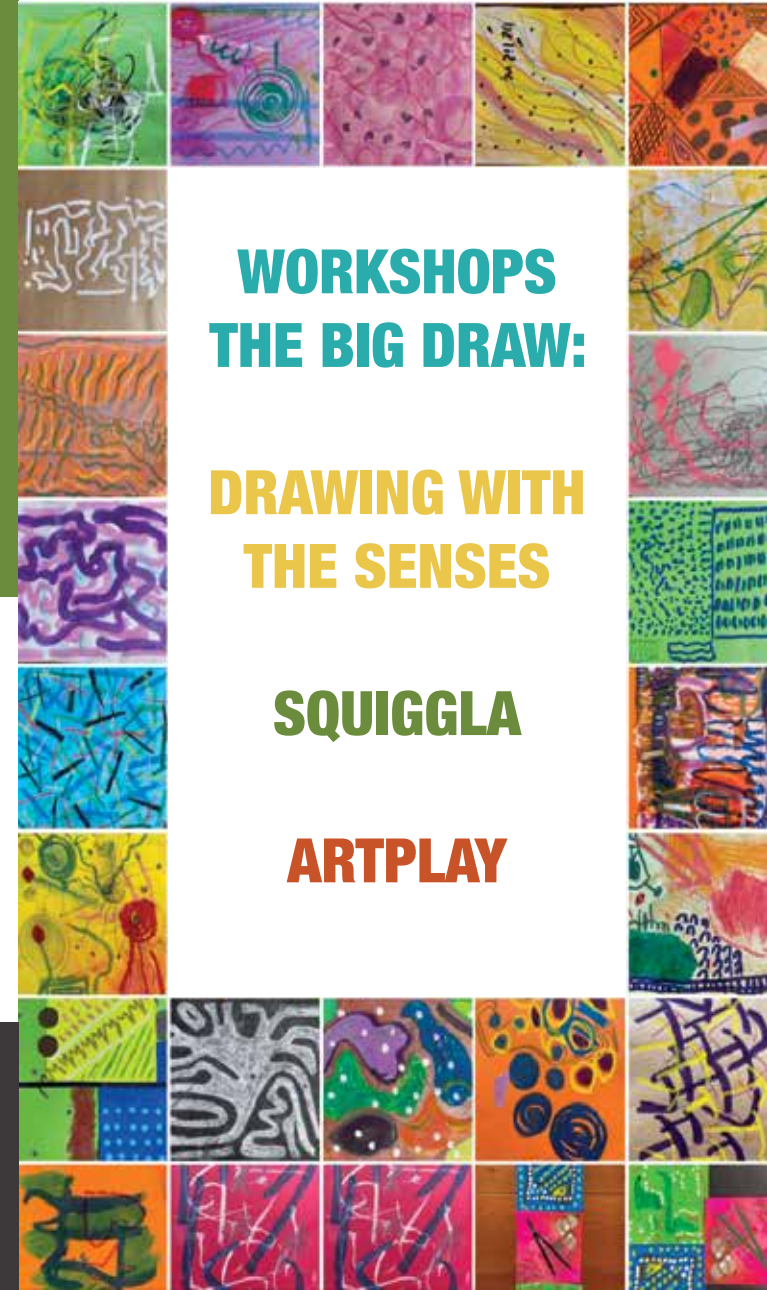

Expressive Painting

Tuesday 12 December



This kids workshop is inspired by the wonderful Squiggle drawing program, this class will go a step further and introduce painting. Your child will explore drawing lines, shapes, and repetition before moving onto colour mixing and applying paint. This hands-on experience is playful and expressive, resulting in colourful abstract paintings with a frame for your wall at home.



Monster Mash

Wednesday 13 December

In this collage workshop your child will be guided to create a monster out of colour paper, watercolour paper, and mixed media. This fun hands-on experience of cutting up paper and crafting wild creatures lets them explore their artistic talents and show off their inventiveness.

Clay Creations

Tuesday 19 December

This air-drying clay workshop will uncover how to use hand building techniques to create a small vessel. We will use coil and pinch pot techniques to explore the art of sculpting. This hands-on experience is playful and lets your child explore working with and moulding three dimensional forms.

Crafty Treasures

Wednesday 20 December

Join this festive kids workshop crafting ornaments using air dry clay. The ornaments can adorn a tree or just brighten up your home. This workshop is playful and fosters creativity during the holiday season.

After Matisse

Tuesday 9 January



Watch as colours collide and creativity soars in this vibrant kids workshop! Join us for an exciting day of paper-cutting and shape arranging, turning imagination into large abstract masterpieces. A fun-filled, experimental experience awaits, where every cut shapes a world of endless possibilities.

Drawing with the Senses

Wednesday 10 January



Join us for a sensory journey of artistic discovery! In response to the Big Draw this workshop will explore drawing as a sensory experience. Feeling the texture of plant materials, such as pods and leaves, your child will create a tactile drawing communicating the sensory experience through lines, shapes and forms. Once the images are drawn, we will go a step further and add colour using watercolour pallets.

Botanical Brush

Tuesday 16 January



In this hands-on workshop, children embark on a creative journey, crafting unique brushes from natural plant materials. Exploring the tactile wonders of leaves, twigs, and more, they then dip their handcrafted brushes into vibrant inks. The artistic magic unfolds as they drag and drip ink onto canvases, turning imagination into colourful reality.

Soundscape Sketches

Wednesday 17 January



An experiential workshop, where your ears guide your artistic hands. Equipped with drawing tools, become immersed in sound, capturing the rhythm of music and the whispers of nature. Each stroke becomes a visual melody, transforming auditory sensations into vibrant, expressive art.
